TALK

1. Why is it a bad idea to give big-kid stuff to a baby? They don't know what it's for; they might make a mess; they might get hurt.
2. Why do you think you're good at using the big-kid stuff? I know what it's for, I can use them correctly, I can be trusted with them, etc.

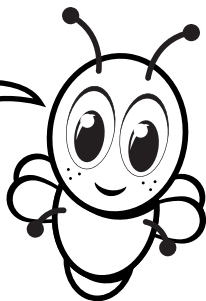

Blinky's Family Challenge

I can do big stuff for God ... *when I do the little stuff each day!*



Lead Me

When you do the little stuff each day, you can be trusted to do big stuff for God! Practice something little to see if you're ready to do something bigger!

You'll Need

- A blindfold

Directions

1. Let your child lead you to a place on the **Places** list with your eyes open.
2. Say, "You did great! That was a little thing because my eyes were open. Now I can trust you to do something bigger!"
3. Put on the blindfold.

4. Let your child lead you to the same place, with the blindfold on.
5. Repeat for each place on the list, but use a different leader each time.

Places

- Kitchen
- Bathroom
- Bedroom
- Outside

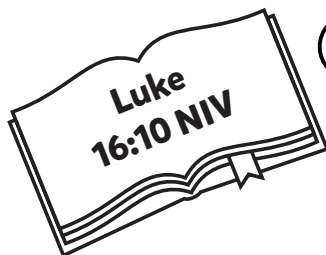


Guy the Bible Guy

Do the little stuff! Then, God trusts you to do big stuff for Him!

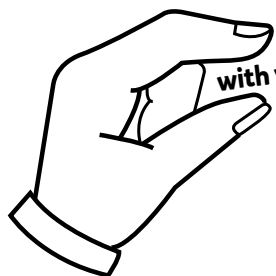

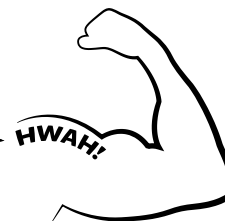
